Our team of four Quant Developers is part of Markets Business Technology. We work closely with traders to translate business requirements into reports and applications, using financial models provided by Model Quants and data delivered by IT teams.

We are located on the trading floor in Copenhagen, but we are now also expanding our presence to Helsinki where other teams in Markets Business Technology are already present - we are looking for people in both cities.

Main responsibilities in this role:

- Contribute to the development of our Kotlin-based library that contains the core business logic of our platform.
- Turn business requirements into solutions in close collaboration with both end users in trading and IT teams in technology.
- Provide second-line support for new and existing functionality when our support team needs assistance.

- Strong understanding of software engineering and computer science fundamentals.
