Your daily:

As a part of the team, you will be responsible for the design, development, and maintenance of backend services using C# and .NET Core. Additionally, you will collaborate closely with various stakeholders and contribute to the team's collective success.

Key responsibilities includes experience with CI/CD pipelines, including automating build, test, and deployment processes using Azure DevOps (with Azure Pipelines and YAML) and GitHub Actions.

Furthermore;

- Implementing and optimising RESTful APIs for internal and external integrations.
- Managing data with Microsoft SQL Server.
- Integrating and supporting messaging solutions using IBM MQ.
- Containerising and deploying applications using Docker, AWS, Windows servers and OpenShift.
- Monitoring and troubleshooting production systems with Prometheus, ELK (Elasticsearch, Kibana), and Grafana.
- Designing, implementing, and executing performance and load tests to ensure system reliability and scalability.
- Writing clean, maintainable, and testable following best practices and SOLID principles.
- Participating in code reviews, testing, and best practice adoption.

You will also:

- Help grow and upskill Software Engineering colleagues.
- Actively contribute to agile ceremonies and team goals.

What we imagine you bring

We are looking for a highly skilled professional with over 5 years of experience in C#/.NET backend development and REST APIs. You should have a strong technical background and a passion for collaboration and continuous improvement.

Key qualifications include:

- Strong expertise in C#/.NET backend development and REST APIs.
- In-depth knowledge of Microsoft SQL Server.
- Hands-on experience with Docker, AWS, and OpenShift for containerisation and cloud deployments.
- Proficiency in integrating with enterprise messaging systems such as IBM MQ.
- Familiarity with GitHub and Azure DevOps for source control and CI/CD.
- Advanced skills in writing unit tests, integration tests and using performance testing tools.
- A good grasp of software design patterns and best practices.
- An interest in wanting to learn and understand a complex business domain within the back-office processes of securities and fund settlement.

You should also possess:

- Excellent skills in writing clean, maintainable, and well-structured code.
- Strong teamwork, communication, and analytical abilities.
- Experience mentoring and guiding colleagues to improve their technical skills.
- A willingness to learn and improve constantly, coupled with a positive attitude.
- Advanced proficiency in English, both written and verbal.
